### Orange Room Highlights from July

We were excited that the Camp Little Cloud theme of STEM matched the classroom theme! The children were able to create a HUGE maze that they could walk through. We used chairs, tables, and toys to make it.

Once each child figured out how to get through the maze, we made a small maze for hand-eye coordination.

Each child picked out a cut-up cereal box.

First, they decorated their own box. Then the teachers helped each child glue strips of paper towel and toilet paper rolls onto the box. This was big enough to let a golf ball go through it.

By using both hands, the children would hold their own maze box to tilt it. The golf ball would roll through the strips. We saw some adults trying it out, too!





#### Adventure Club with Mr. Brian



This summer, Mr. Brian has been challenging your children's creativity during Adventure Clubs on Tuesdays. One of the favorites for the children was when Mr. Brian created a zipline in the room. It started at the top of the door and ended at the top of a bookshelf. The children were tasked with creating a "vehicle"
